Preston Windrush Generation & Descendants UK (PWGD UK) began when the daughter of our founder, Sekeena Kydd, had her passport application declined for a school trip to Spain in July 2019.

This began an investigation into what would reveal to be a much wider problem affecting many more people's immigration status in different ways. Since then, Sekeena Kydd and Glenda Andrews have worked tirelessly to support the victims of the Windrush Scandal and all those who have found themselves affected by the 'hostile environment'.

PWGD is part of a network of grassroots support groups across the UK. Working with prominent figures and officials to defend our right to exist peacefully in this country.
